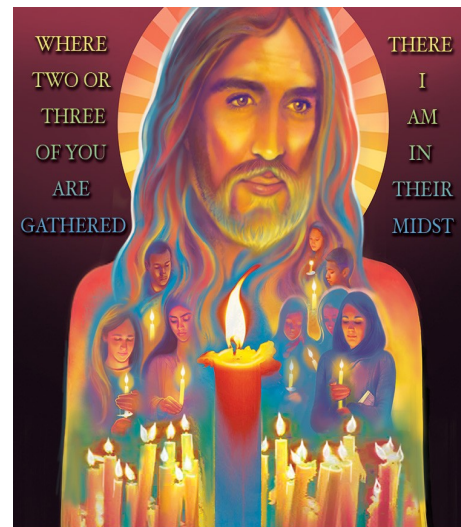

## **Novena Background:**
