**Electronic Tithing (or e-Tithing)** is coming to St. Patrick Catholic Church! Beginning April 1, 2018, you can sign up to have your tithe automatically debited from your account, just like you use for utility, mortgage, cell phone and TV payments. We are offering e-Tithing as a convenience to you, and consistency to St. Patrick Catholic Church. e-Tithing eliminates frequent check writing and helps you stay on track with your tithe - even when you are unable to attend Mass in Chanute. St. Patrick benefits from much-needed donation consistency, and a reduction in the volume and liability of check and cash contributions that must be handled and manually processed. Sign up is EASY! You can stop by the Rectory to sign an e-Tithing form and simply choose the amount and frequency of your tithe. St. Patrick will then automatically debit your account in the amount and frequency you've specified. You will still receive credit for your tithe in your end of year statement and e-Tithing is free! Furthermore, your bank statement will show the exact date and amount of your tithe. And just like other automatic payments, you can cancel or change your tithe anytime by coming into the Rectory. - Less work and liability processing checks and cash each week;

As many of you know, St. Patrick's is embarking on **Investing in our future...Preserving our past** capital campaign. An important part of this campaign involves contacting all members through a personal visit. The primary purpose of these visits is to deliver pledge information for the campaign. Another equally important part is to create a greater sense of community within our parish.

In the next month you may receive a call from a parish member asking you to become a home visitor or a campaign visitor. Home visitors will be provided a short training where you will receive your materials. They will be delivering pledge materials to approximately 5 households and that same volunteer will return a week later and pick up the pledge card in a sealed security envelope and return it to the church. We hope that you welcome these calls, agree to help, and be a volunteer for our parish. You will not ask for money, only deliver the materials.

We are one family of faith and believe this campaign will help us achieve a bold vision for our parish, as well as assist us in growing closer as a community to strengthen our mission in Christ.
