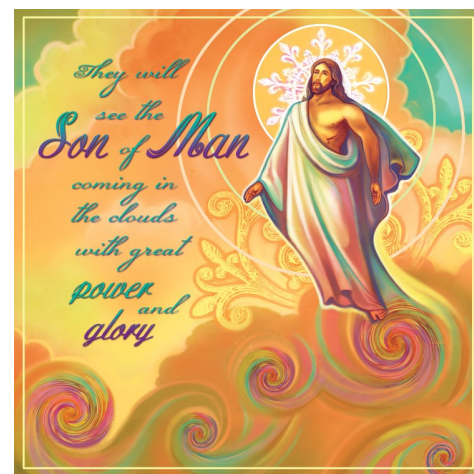

**Capital Campaign Update:** Weather permitting, work will continue this week on the outside of the Church. The workers are nearing completion of the deep-cleaning of the masonry (brick and capstones) of the exterior walls and towers of the Church. Once completed, they will tuck point where needed, and then apply a waterproofing agent/sealant over the surface in order to protect the masonry from further water damage. Also this week, the roofing of the Church will take place. Please note: the Church parking lot will not be fully accessible during the re-roofing of the Church. Thanks in advance for your patience and understanding.

**"Fully Alive as Missionary Disciples"** We have a saying that "all good things must come to an end." As we prepare for Advent, we must note that our church year has come to an end. The apocalyptic nature of today's readings should cause us to reflect on this ending. Mark's Gospel tells us we will "see 'the Son of Man coming in the clouds' with great power and glory, and then he will send out the angels and gather his elect from the four winds, from the end of the earth to the end of the sky." I think most of us agree that we want to be part of this "elect" that Mark mentions. How do we ensure that we are marked for that day? We begin with baptism, which is a public declaration of our acceptance of Jesus Christ as the Son of God and as our redeemer. But we have to remember the words of the apostle Paul: Faith without works is dead. In baptism we are called into a life of discipleship. We are called to live out our faith in every word and deed of every day. Next week we celebrate commitment Sunday, when you will have an opportunity to recommit yourself as a disciple of Jesus Christ. Take a quiet moment this week to reflect on the end of this liturgical year and the beginning of a new one. How will you allow yourself to become fully alive in discipleship in the coming year?
