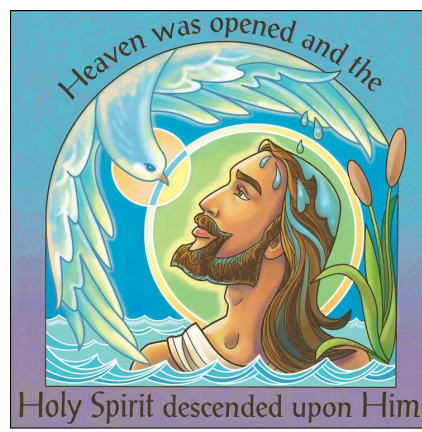

**Capital Campaign Update:** The re-roofing the Church should be finished this week (was delayed last week). The final two areas of the roof that are now being addressed are the west parapet wall (above the choir loft) and the east roof of the Church. Those involved have taken more time in the planning, design, and re-engineering of these areas, so that the water issues are correctly addressed and will not re-occur.

As you all know, the dome of the Church was removed on Thursday. However, after its removal the crew discovered more extensive damage inside the top of the tower. As a result, we will need to do more work than expected before the new dome is set in place. The original cross on the old dome will be either re-used on the new dome or placed somewhere on our parish grounds. In addition, construction should continue for the new restrooms in the old confessional area. The temporary confessional is located in the right sacristy, and a lamp is being used to show when it is occupied. Thanks again for your prayers, patience, and understanding while these much needed improvements are being made!
