**Lenten Fast & Abstinence Regulations** - *Ash Wednesday & Good Friday are days of fasting.* Catholics who are ages 18 to 59 are obliged to fast, that is, take only one full meal and two lesser meals, with nothing to eat in between meals. Drinking fluids would not be contrary to the practice of fasting. *Ash Wednesday, the Fridays of Lent, and Good Friday are days of abstaining from meat.* All Catholics who are 14 years of age and older are obliged to abstain from eating meat.

**Wednesdays of Lent** the school children will have Stations of the Cross at 2:30pm, everyone welcome!

**English Stations of the Cross** on Fridays during Lent at 6:30pm at St. Patrick Catholic Church and 7:30pm at St. Joseph Catholic Church.

**Spanish Stations of the Cross** will be on Fridays during Lent at 5:30pm.

**"Fully Alive as Missionary Disciples"** Today's gospel speaks to the importance of discipleship and training. We are called to be "like the teacher," which means living a life of mercy, generosity, and compassion. Jesus tells us not to worry about the splinter in our neighbor's eye, and to work on removing the wooden beam from our own eye. We cannot disciple well when we are spiritually blinded -- a blind guide is a false guide who will lead others into a pit. If we are to be authentic in our discipleship, we must regain our sight, but how? We can pray, go to Mass, study scripture, make a good confession, and recall our baptismal promises. Jesus the teacher wants us to be star pupils! He wants us to help one another! But first, he wants us to recognize our own struggles before we condemn others for theirs.
