

Capital Campaign Update: As you have probably noticed, progress is being made in the various construction projects on campus. Currently, the crew is redesigning our drainage system around the foundation of the Church. The water damage on the west exterior wall of the gym is now being addressed as well. In addition, while we were evaluating the Church's north entrance flooring, it was discovered that the exterior St. Patrick Catholic School in the amount of \$1,722.00 steps and landing (concrete) are not resting on a stable foundation. As a result, we must rebuild the north entrance steps and landing. The completion of the restrooms is drawing closer, along with the flooring in the gathering space of the Church. Lastly, weather permitting, the new dome should arrive this week and be secured on top of the tower! The dome's cross is still being fabricated and will be installed when completed.
