**Stewardship Reflections** - Discipleship demands 100% faith in God in His plans for our lives. In the second reading, Paul describes the faith of Abraham, who obeyed God's commands, accepted the mission laid before him, and trusted that God would provide all He'd promised to provide. In the reading from Luke, we hear Jesus giving a similar message to his disciples: "Sell your belongings and give alms." His message is to stop clinging to that which is worldly and in your control. "Do not be afraid any longer, little flock, for your Father is pleased to give you the kingdom." Our call to discipleship can seem reckless and scary. We want to be prepared to handle situations on Earth, but Jesus says leave those to God and work instead toward being prepared for the kingdom, "for at an hour you do not expect, the Son of Man will come."
